# TRAVELLING TO SPAIN - VACCINATED

#1	Join the WhatsApp Group	<a href="#">Click Here</a> - Password Tennis2022	To connect with other clients and coaches on your trip
#2	Download your Itinerary	<a href="#">Click Here</a>	So you know the key timings
#3	Check your Vaccine Status	<a href="#">Click Here</a> At least 14 days must have passed since being fully vaccinated (with both doses of a 2-dose vaccine or one dose of a single-dose vaccine) before arrival in Spain. Your date(s) of vaccination must be specified and your final dose must have been administered within 270 days prior to travel to Spain. If you completed your vaccination (with both doses of a 2-dose vaccine or one dose of a single-dose vaccine) more than 270 days prior to travel to Spain, you must be able to show proof of having received a booster jab. There is no requirement for 14 days to have passed between receiving your booster jab and entering Spain. Booster jabs can be administered at any time prior to travel to Spain.	
#4	Download your Vaccine Certificate	Follow the instructions <a href="#">here</a>	You must present this when Checking In at the Airport and/or on arrival
#5	Complete PLF Form	<a href="#">Click Here</a>	For entry to Spain
#6	Purchase a Mask	The use of face coverings is mandatory for anyone over the age of 6 years old on all forms of public transport in Spain and in many other indoor public spaces.

#3	Have proof of Covid-19 recovery in the last 6 months	<p>If you're travelling to Spain for tourism purposes, are not fully vaccinated but have recovered from prior COVID-19 infection in the last 6 months, you can use the <a href="#">UK proof of COVID-19 recovery record</a> or a recovery certificate issued by a relevant health authority or medical service to certify your COVID-19 status.</p> <p>At least 11 days must have passed since your first positive COVID-19 nucleic acid amplification test - NAAT (PCR or similar) or rapid antigen test. The recovery record or certificate will be valid for 180 days from the date of the positive test.</p>

#5	Purchase a Mask	The use of face coverings is mandatory for anyone over the age of 6 years old on all forms of public transport in Spain and in many other indoor public spaces.
